REGISTRATION

Registration kicks off on Friday, 1 August 2025 at 13h00, in the hall at the *Swellendam Show Grounds*. Prior to arrival you will receive an SMS confirming your race number, you will need to show this at registration to receive your race pack and goodie bag. This year each rider will receive a goodie bag packed with treats from our sponsors.

In your race pack you will receive a *number board* with cable ties and a *wristband*. The number board must be securely fastened to your front handle bars, the number board is also your timing chip so make sure the number on it is your race number. The number board must be returned after the finish. Your wristband must be worn at all times during your race, this has the event emergency number on it, and is your ticket to receive a well-deserved free hamburger from Food Lover's Market after you finish.

Substitutions can only be done at Registration at a cost of R150 per person.



IMPORTANT RACE DAY INFO

RACE DAY EMERGENCY NUMBER 072 226 4849

Before you set off on your gravel adventure there's some very important information that you need to take note of. Your race briefing will take place 15 minutes before the start of your race on the start line.

- Your **number board is your timing chip**, make sure it is fastened securely to your handle bars.
- Always wear your colour-coded armband with the event emergency number.
- Only one batch per distance with self seeding.
- The first 7 km and last 7 km is a neutral zone @ 20km/h.
- Familiarise yourself with the information in this booklet regarding the routes and support box rules for your distance.
- The road is marked with yellow boards with red arrows. Only turn when there is a board showing you need to turn.
- Always obey marshals, only turn at arrows or marshals, do not turn otherwise.
- Caution on all downhills as there will be some water damage on some downhills.
- No helmet no ride / no earphones allowed.
- E-bikes are welcome, but there will be no separate category or prizes.





- Take caution in the last 3km through town roads and traffic points. Make sure you have enough hydration to get you to the next water point. Remember your free bike wash & lube at the end and lube at all water points.
- Hand in your number board at the end and collect your hamburger and Coke with your armband.
- There are sweep vehicles and medics on route. Please phone the emergency number on your wristband if you need assistance.
- Absolutely NO LITTERING will be tolerated outside of the designated waterpoints and "chuck zones".
- We are deeply appreciative of the landowners that allow our routes and riders to pass through their private property, please be respectful and stick to the routes marked out.
- Any riders or teams not abiding by this rule will face immediate disqualification.



OUPLAAS NEUTRAL ZONE

- You have **30 minutes** to stop at the Ouplaas Neutral Zone.
- Make sure to enter and exit **THROUGH IN/OUT** timing points at Ouplaas
- Make sure to go through the Gazebo at the EXIT point at Ouplaas to start your timing again
- CUT-OFF time is 14h00 at Ouplaas for the 60 and 100 milers.

WHATTOPACK

Make your ride as smooth as possible by ensuring you pack the following items



HELMET

No helmet, no ride!



WARM CLOTHES

This is South Africa's premier winter race, day temperatures should be fine but expect a chilly start in the morning and low temperatures throughout the night.



SHOES & SOCKS

Depending on the weather, you might appreciate a clean pair of socks after many muddy miles on the gravel.



MOBILE PHONE

Fully charged, remember to save the race day emergency number **(072 226 4849)**. This will also be on your wristband.



BIKE REPAIR KIT

Including tubes, chain links, lube and whatever else could help you in a sticky situation. Mechanical assistance will be available at the race village but you need to be self sufficient on route.



HYDRATION PACKS & WATER BOTTLES

There will be well-stocked water points every 25 - 45km, bring your own bottles and hydration packs to refill along the way.



SUNSCREEN & SUNGLASSES

Even though it's winter, sunscreen is always a good idea.



GPS

Event KMZ and GPX files are available on the website, please load them beforehand to reduce your race day stress.



LIGHTS

100 miler riders make sure you have rear red lights as you will be setting off in limited light in the morning.

This route is Cyclo Cross/MTB/Gravel Bike friendly. Please come prepared for all weather conditions. It can be nice and sunny, but also rainy and muddy.

OUPLAAS NEUTRAL ZONE:

You will have 30 minutes to rest and refuel. Any time over 30 minutes spent at Ouplaas will be added to your time. Here you will be treated to real Overberg hospitality and a roosterkoek prepared by Swellendam Primary School. At this Checkpoint you will be able to meet your team support vehicle or support box. Team times will be calculated with the last rider's time into the Neutral Zone and the first rider out of the Neutral Zone.

ON ROUTE & WATER POINTS:

You will leave Swellendam at 07h30am and reach Water point 1 (31km) at about 09h00 - 09h30.

There are 6 water points on route with water, Coke, energy drink and eats.


